Robberies 019th District (Area North)

About the Crime:

This alert gives notice to citizens residing in the 19th District (Area North) of an increase in Robbery related incidents that have occurred during the month of February. In these incidents, offender(s) used force and threat of force and taking personal property. Incident times and locations are listed below:

- 3000 Block of N. Greenview Ave on February 21, 2016 at approximately 01:30 A.M.
- 2800 Block of N. Racine Ave on February 24, 2016 at approximately 04:40 A.M.
- 3500 Block of N. Clark St. on February 28, 2016 at approximately 02:30 A.M.

About the Offenders:

 In one incident Offender(s) descriptions are male between 20-30 years of age. In the other incidents Offenders are described as male black between the 20-30 years of age. Offender(s) arrive and flee on foot from the crime scenes.

What you can do:

- Always be aware of your surroundings.
- Report suspicious activity immediately
- If you are confronted by an assailant remain calm
- Remember any unique physical characteristics (ie., scars, limp, acne, teeth)
- Never pursue a fleeing assailant, provide the information to the police
- If approached by a witness to the incident, request contact information
- Dial 9-1-1 immediately and remain on scene when possible
